2.1. EXPERT ADVISORY & GRIEVANCE COMMITTEE

- a. **Representation Before The Income Tax Department:** With the support of members of **Expert Advisory and Grievance Committee** and also the suggestions from the senior members from time to time representations and suggestions were made before Hon'ble Finance Minister, Chairman-CBDT, Member-CBDT, Pr. The ITBA had got an opportunity to make some important suggestions with respect to Income Tax & Finance Act, accordingly detailed representation was made before the Hon'ble Chairman of CBDT Shri. Nitin Gupta. The concerns raised by the ITBA were appreciated by the Chairman who not only addressed the same but same were considered while passing the Finance Act.

The Present Fees of Rs. 1200 was effective from FY 2020-21, thus the Membership Fees stands increased to Rs. 1400/- from FY 2023-24.
